**StoryCorps is a national nonprofit organization whose mission is to provide Americans of all backgrounds and beliefs with the opportunity to record, share, and preserve the stories of our lives.**

Since 2003, tens of thousands of everyday people have shared stories and conversations with loved ones through StoryCorps. Each conversation is recorded on a free CD to share and is preserved in the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress. StoryCorps is one of the largest oral history projects of its kind, and millions listen to our weekly broadcasts at [storycorps.org](http://storycorps.org) and on NPR's *Morning Edition*.

### **ABOUT STORYCORPS LEGACY**

StoryCorps Legacy provides people with life-threatening conditions and their families the opportunity to record, preserve, and share their stories. Recording interviews is the perfect way to celebrate and share the lives of our loved ones with generations to come. StoryCorps has heard many participants say they strengthened their human connections and felt their lives were validated as a result of their interviews.

### **PARTNERING WITH STORYCORPS LEGACY**

StoryCorps Legacy partners with organizations that serve people with life-threatening conditions and their families. These include hospice care, palliative care, and disease-specific organizations. We assist them in incorporating the StoryCorps interview experience into their existing services.
